

ARTWORK SPECIFICATIONS

The following artwork specifications are required for accurate printing. If you have any queries, please don't hesitate to contact us .

File Type

1. allsigns print & design only accepts artwork files as PDF finished artwork.
2. PDF file must be flattened with Adobe distiller or similar to ensure proper viewing of artwork.
3. Multiple page art to be supplied as 1 up artworks per pages.

allsigns print & design cannot accept responsibility for errors due to files supplied incorrectly.

Please **contact our office** should you require any additional information or clarification on these specifications.

Colour Format

All colours must be supply in CMYK (Cyan, Magenta, Yellow and Black) no RGB. This includes fonts, graphics or images used within the documents.

Fonts and Text

All fonts used in the artwork must be converted to curves/outlines before exporting the file for printing.

Image Quality

All images being used are to be supplied in a CMYK format. A minimum of 300dpi is recommended for printing.

Bleed

10mm bleed for signs / 2mm bleed for documents is required. "Bleed" is a printing term which refers to the extra colour that extends beyond the edges of the final document, which is trimmed later. This helps avoid inconsistencies and visible registration issues.
